- 2. I accept my responsibility to ski safely at all times, to abide by the Skier Responsibility Code, and to obey all posted behavior notices and any other ski area rules and policies. Any equipment I use while skiing, I use at my own risk.
- 3. I agree that I will not sue or make a claim against Rokka Ski School, Rokka Ski Club, Rokka Ski Lodge, Boyne USA Inc., or any of its owners, officers, agents, or subsidiaries, including but not limited to, Ski Lifts Inc., Crystal Mountain, Inc., Alterra Mountain Company; and the U. S.
